



COVID-19 Terms & Conditions : Camping 21.12.20

Bellingen Showground is working to an industry standard COVID Safe Plan which includes :

- Increased cleaning standards and intervals
- Contactless check-in
- Social distancing signage across our facilities
- Guest Health Declarations in accordance with the NSW Health Orders
- Contact record keeping in accordance with the NSW Health Orders

Bellingen Showground is complying with the NSW Health Checklist for COVID-19 Safety in Camping Grounds & Caravan Parks. This requires all guests and visitors to comply with the following :

All campers are required to complete the Health Declaration confirming health and entry to the showground. Completed Guest Declarations will be retained for at least 28 days and for the purpose of any checks or contact tracing activities by authorities. The Health Declaration forms will only be used for the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections and are stored confidentially and securely.

Campers are encouraged to download the COVIDSafe app

(<https://www.health.gov.au/resources/apps-and-tools/covidsafe-app>). However even guests with the COVIDSafe app will still be required to complete the Health Declaration.

Anyone who has respiratory symptoms or fever (>37.5°), even if they only have mild symptoms, **MUST :**

1. Advise the Camping Co-ordinator
2. Immediately get tested for COVID-19 and;
3. Place themselves in isolation until they have received their result.

There is a COVID testing clinic at 15-23 Watson St Bellingen, run by the local GP's. Details of opening hours can be found on the Bellingen Shire Council website (bellingshireconnects.com.au/covid-clinic).

Everyone must comply with government and Public Health Order directions while on the premises. This includes but is not limited to :

- Not exceeding the prevailing maximum capacity allowed in all communal areas, notably the amenities. Bellingen Showground has provided capacity signage in these spaces to advise the maximum number of people that can occupy the area.
- Maintain 1.5metres physical distancing.
- Campers should practice good hand hygiene.
- Rules and conditions must be followed, included following the instructions of the Camping Co-ordinator or Board members who manage the showground.

Visitors to a campsite must register via QR code or the sheet outside the Main Amenities.

Campers are requested to stay away from the **equestrian areas**.
